Sugarhill Ave Exit to JB Blvd is DEADLY...

For many years people have been complaining about how dangerous exiting onto Jensen Beach Boulevard from Sugarhill Avenue is, especially during the high season.

Now we are confronted with the popularity of the new Aldi store, creating a much worse situation. Considering the potential of 400 or more vehicles through that intersection in a day, the situation at this point is becoming unbearable and likely to get somebody injured.

There can be as many as 200 vehicles in Sugarhill alone that potentially could go through that intersection daily. Then there is the Marquisis building and the Mosque who also use that intersection. Also all the

maintenance people in and out have to be considered.

The western exit for Aldi's is way too close to Sugar Hill Avenue to be safe. People turning right out of this plaza exit look left to see oncoming traffic and rarely look right before they start their turn, dangerous.

It would seem the most logical conclusion would be to move it further east away from Sugarhill Avenue and close off the existing west entrance. This is assuming the parking lot is required to have three entrance-exits.

Closing off the western exit may be all that is needed. This would still have 2 exits for the parking areas of the plaza.
